There are a range of appointments available with GPs, nurses, healthcare assistants and phlebotomists (blood tests). This is to provide greater appointment availability and flexibility for people. Patients can book directly for phlebotomy* (blood tests) and dressings, excluding leg ulcers, using tel number 03000 240009.

People must be registered with a GP surgery locally to access these additional appointments which can only be booked in advance through your own GP practice. The service cannot accept walk-in patients.

The appointments are for routine general practice issues only and not for urgent care. For more information, please contact your GP practice. Patients will be given the location of their appointment at the time of making a booking.

If urgent care is required, please call NHS 111 for advice.
